Details of competitions

Entries and the competition programme may be limited and revised at the discretion of the Organising Committee.

COMPETITIONS 1 to 10 (Preliminary to Advanced)

- **Limit on Numbers:** 30 Horses (The OC will consider allowing a max. 35 entries depending on entries)
- **Champions** to be decided on point system of both competitions at each level. Refer Rule 8.1 EA Dressage Rule Book.
- **Eligibility:** Refer page 3 & 4.

COMPETITION 11: Advanced Freestyle

Open to horse/riders who have qualified/been accepted for the Advanced competitions. The number of entries will be limited to around 12/15 competitors depending on the time available. Participation will be determined by performances submitted at Advanced level.

COMPETITIONS 12*, 13, 14, 15 Prix St Georges (2009), Intermediate I (2009), Intermediate II (2009), Grand Prix (2009)

- **Limit on Numbers:** 30 Horses (*The OC will consider allowing a max. 35 entries depending on entries and time constraints).
- **Eligibility:** Refer pages 3 & 4.

COMPETITION 16: FEI Grand Prix Special (2009)

The Grand Prix Special is limited to the best 12 combinations entered that gain at least 55% in the Grand Prix. Participation is **not compulsory** for combinations that qualify and entry fees will be refunded to the combinations that enter and do not qualify. Riders **are permitted to ride both the Grand Prix Freestyle and the Grand Prix Special**.

COMPETITION 17: Intermediate Freestyle to Music (2009)

Open to horse/riders who have qualified/been accepted for the Intermediate I championship. The number of entries will be limited to 12. Participation will be determined by performances submitted at Intermediate I level.

COMPETITION 18: FEI Grand Prix Freestyle to Music (2009)

The top 12 placegetters, who must earn a minimum score of 55% in the qualifying Grand Prix competition, will be eligible to start in the Freestyle competition. Entry fees will be refunded to the combinations that do not qualify for the Freestyle. Refer page 4.

COMPETITION 12*: Australian Prix St Georges Challenge – NSW State Final: (FEI Prix St Georges Test 2009).

Refer to EA Dressage rules 8.12-8.19. The NSW state final will be run in conjunction with competition 12. The winner of the state final will be presented at the final presentation ceremony on Sunday. There is no additional entry fee for this competition.

- **State Teams** competition entries must be made by the appropriate State Branch in writing by the closing date of entries **30 July 2010**. **Regional Team** entries must be made by a Team Manager by close of entries **30 July 2010**.
- Declaration of the team to be made in writing to OC by the relevant Chefs d'Equipe or Team Managers by **5 pm Thursday, 9 September 2010**. **Declaration forms available from the event office in the indoor arena.**
- Chefs d'Equipe must be appointed for Official State Teams. Refer page 10 for Team Entry form

Competitions 21-22: Young Horse Qualifiers for 4 and 5 old horses.

The young horse qualifiers will be conducted under rules for a young horse qualifier (Section 5, 5.2 of EA Dressage rules). Horses must exceed 149cms. Qualifying events consist of one round with the following tests:

- **4 YO:** The highest current EA Preliminary test 1D; **5 YO:** FEI Young Horse Preliminary test for 5-year olds;
- The birth dates for all horses will be as at 1st August.
 - 4yo qualifier for horses born between 1/8/06 and 31/7/07
 - 5yo qualifier for horses born between 1/8/05 and 31/7/06
(There is no qualification requirement for Young Horse classes, however preference will be given to those entered in the NSW Championships by ranking order)

Conditions of Entry and General Information

- The event will be conducted in accordance with the current EA Rules for Dressage, EA General Regs and FEI rules.
- Horses must be registered with, and owners and riders be financial members of the EA, or if not Australian, with their respective National Federation
- All tests are for horses exceeding 149 cm with shoes or 148 cms without shoes.
- Riders must be 12 year of age and over on the day of competition.
- Riders may be changed at any time for any reason. Only one rider per horse for the Championships The Organising Committee must be advised of all changes. Horses can not be changed.
- Non Competitive** (Hors Concours) entries will not be accepted.
- Official grading** will be taken as at the date of close of entries. The following points apply.
Prel/Nov: open to horses with less than 60 points: **Elem:** less than 120 points: **Med:** less than 180 points; **Adv.** less than 240 points: **FEI level:** as per current EA Dressage Rules. Photocopies of grading cards or EA printouts must accompany entry forms for verification of performance. It is the rider's responsibility to have the grading card up to date. Grading cards and registration cards must be surrendered to the Event secretary prior to the competition upon request.
- Performance eligibility:** the qualifying period runs from the **31 July 2009 to the 30 July 2010**. All entries for EA and FEI Level tests must be qualified by having gained at least the following: **Prelim to Elementary;** one performance of **65% or higher;** **Medium and Advanced** one performance of at least **60% or higher;** **FEI Levels,** one performance of **55% or higher** is compulsory at the level they are entering during the 12-month period preceding the closing date.

9. All combinations must submit **their best three performances** in an **Official Test** at the appropriate level, since **31 July 2009** to the closing date for entries, **30 July 2010**. See above re minimum performance requirement. **Eventing, Associate, Freestyle and restricted Young Rider or Young Horse dressage results are not considered.**
10. **Only one HC** (non competitive) score is allowed to count at each level entered.
11. **Ranking (balloting)** will be based on the average of the highest percentages of three tests at the particular level, in the 12 months preceding the close of entries. **Riders who submit 3 performances (only one of which may be Non Competitive - HC) will be considered ahead of those who submit one or two performances. (Rule 8.2).**
12. **Withdrawals (Scratchings) and Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date of entries unless a medical or veterinary certificate is produced **within 24 hours** of the completion of the event. In such cases, 50% of the entry fees will be retained by the O.C. Entry fees will be refunded in full for withdrawals before the closing date, and, for riders on the reserve list who are not offered a start in a competition. The administration fee will **not be refunded**
13. Championships for EA levels are to be decided on points with all horses ranked in each of the two tests (as per EA rules for National Championships).
14. **Prize money:** In the case of a tie for any of the first three places, the higher total of the 4 collective marks will decide the highest placing. If these marks are tied, the placings remain tied. When there is equality of places from 4th place and below, the competitors are joint equal placegetters.
15. **Grand Prix riders** may ride both the Grand Prix Special and the Grand Prix Freestyle.
16. **Bridle numbers** must be worn at all times during warm up and competition, and whenever a horse is out of its stable.
17. No test may be commanded.
18. **Swabbing** – Random swabbing will take place and will be conducted in accordance with EA/FEI Veterinary Regulations
19. **Entry forms** must be correctly and fully completed. Entry fees must accompany entry forms. Any mistakes or incomplete information will result in the entry not being accepted and returned for correction. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.**
20. **Camping facilities** are available at AELEC. Please go to www.aelec.com.au for more information
21. **Catering** facilities will be available from Friday morning.
22. **Regional NSW Teams and State Teams:** Although individual team entries must be lodged by closing date of entries, the name of the three horse/rider combinations must be lodged in writing with the Secretary at the office no later than **5.00pm on Thursday 9 September 2010**. Refer to page 10 for entry form.
23. Riders and/or owners whose entries have been accepted, will undertake to indemnify the Committee against all claims, losses, suits, and other damages made against or suffered by the Committee by reason of any negligent act or omission on the part of any rider trainer, or attendant whilst he/she is attending, riding or otherwise handling a horse, and agree that act or omission on the part of such rider or attendant found in any action against the Committee to be negligent, shall be deemed to have been negligent for the purpose of any claim under this indemnity.
24. Entries and competition program may be limited and revised at the discretion of the Committee.
25. **Presentations** will take place at the completion of each competition where possible or at the end of the day. A presentation schedule will be posted on the score board at the commencement of the Championships. Presentation of NSW Annual Awards, Novice to FEI HOY to be made at the conclusion of the Championships.

Conditions particular to entries in Freestyle Competitions

1. **GRAND PRIX Freestyle** numbers will be limited depending on time constraints – Preference will be given to the highest placegetters in the Grand Prix who have gained 55% or higher. **ADVANCED** and **INTERMEDIATE 1 Freestyles** numbers will be limited, performance at time of entry will determine acceptance to this class.
2. Only the movements up to and included in the current tests at the level being ridden may be shown.
3. Music must be supplied on a good quality CD with **no scratches**. Any relevant instructions attached in writing. **A back-up CD must be available.**
4. Equality of scores: If two competitors receive the same final score, the one with the highest marks for artistic presentation will be the leader.
5. All other conditions of entry pertaining to the NSW Championships will apply.

The 2010 Horse and Rider of the Year

The 2010 Horse and Rider of the Year Awards will be presented at the 2010 ENSW Annual Awards evening.

Della Robertson Memorial Trophy

This trophy, created by renowned artist, Ester Bellis, plus **\$600**– will be presented to the winner of the Grand Prix Freestyle to Music. All riders wishing to be considered for this award **must make available a 125mm x 175mm photo** of their horse for the roll of honour and Winners Gift Trophy on the day of competition. **The prize money will not be paid until the photo and the album is completed.**

The Cinderella Memorial

This annual award will comprise a rug, trophy and \$1000 in prize money.

This annual award has been kindly donated by Claudia and Francis Harper to perpetuate the memory of Cinderella and will comprise a rug, trophy and \$1000 in prize money. The award is directed to riders in the age bracket **21 – 25** who are members of DNSW competing at the NSW Dressage Championships at Medium level and above. Please indicate on the entry form if you are eligible for this award.

REMINDER: Winners of previous trophies are to return trophies to the office during the Championships. **It would be appreciated if trophies could be cleaned and polished where appropriate before returning.**

Welfare of the horse - FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
