Competition 5:	EA Novice 2A
Competition 6:	EA Elementary 3A

Young Horse Tests:

Four year old Highest current EA Preliminary test (1D)

Five year old FEI Young Horse Preliminary test for 5-year-olds

Six year old FEI Young Horse Preliminary test for 6-year-olds

The onus is on the rider/owner to enter the correct competition for the age of their horses.

Entry Fees: \$40.00 per test for Members; \$49.00 per test Non-Members.

Camping: If you wish to camp at the Hawkesbury Showground you **MUST** book and **PAY** in advance. **If you do not book** you will find the gates locked as there is no 24 hour caretaker on the grounds. It is essential for anyone wishing to gain access after hours, to contact Mary Aveyard on **02 4577 3591** during office hours, **9.30am - 4.30pm Mon - Fri.**

Conditions of entry and general information:

- Refer section 5 of the EA Dressage Competition Rules for conditions relating to young horse qualifiers.
- All horses must be registered with the EA.
- All horses must exceed 149cms.
- The birth dates for all horses will be as at 1st August.
 - 4yo qualifier for horses born between 1/8/06 and 31/7/07
 - 5yo qualifier for horses born between 1/8/05 and 31/7/06
 - 6yo qualifier for horses born between 1/8/04 and 31/7/05
- All riders and horse owners must be current financial members of the EA.
- Qualifying events consist of one round, ridden one horse at a time in the arena.
- Two judges will sit together at C to discuss and arrive at a final score for each horse
- Please refer to the EFA rule book for full details relating to young horse qualifiers.
- All horses are to be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Whips are permitted.
- All other dress and saddlery requirements as per the current EA Dressage Rule Book
- **Conditions for Riding Hats:**
 - **Training and practice:** Helmet (approved safety helmet) (at competition venue)
 - **Competition** (inc. final warm-up) Riders under 18 years: Approved safety helmet is required.
 - A top hat may be worn in the 5 and 6 year old competitions at qualifiers.

DNSW allows competitors **who are warming up before their tests to warm up in the sand warm-up arenas in competition attire**. At all other times when training in other areas at the venue, an approved safety helmet as per above must be worn.
