DEFINITIONS:

Judges Seminar (Refer current EA Dressage Rule Book, NOAS section 9) Seminars provide the only opportunity for reaccreditation (maximum every two years) and upgrading. Seminars provide the platform for discussion between judges to find a standard. An EA seminar can only be conducted by approved Judge Educators. **Workshops** may be conducted by other persons approved by the ADJC on recommendation from the SDA (Dressage NSW)

Workshops (Refer current EA Dressage Rule Book, NOAS supplement) Workshops may be held on a variety of subjects. Attendance at Workshops may be used for reaccreditation purposes every other year.

It is imperative for advertising purposes that your function is either referred to as a Seminar or Workshop. In previous years the word "Clinic" has been used however the Rule Book now refers to these functions as per the above definitions. The word "Clinic" now refers to rider education.
